now, so Cees is helping with the activities. Also Mirela, a nice woman from our church, has offered to help us do the Biblical story. She does this in an interactive way, and also with attributes. And we see that the children like it this way, so we are blessed with her work and qualities. Gheorghe is also helping us with the language and other activities. We are happy that the children are getting along with Gheorghe. At first they were a little scared, but they had to get used to see a disabled man.



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The children show their works to Gheorghe and in this way Gheorghe is connected to the group, which is very important to him. We see Gheorghe as a gift from God. He helps us translating to the children and also to other people. He is our interpreter and in this way he contributes to what we are doing here. This is good for his self-esteem because he can now see that he is valuable. The





children are going home with satisfaction and joy every time because of the works and games we are doing. They are happy doing small things, it does not matter to them. The more simple, the more fun.
